

cial Bank is one of the Managers and the Bank of Baroda and the Bank of India are amongst the other banks. The Government of India has agreed to stand Guarantor on behalf of ONGC for the repayment of the loan spread over a period of 7 years. The loan carries an interest of 3/8 per cent LIBOR during the first 2 years and 1/2 per cent over LIBOR over the remaining 5 years. There is also a commitment fee of 3/8 per cent per annum on the undrawn amount. The entire amount of loan is to be drawn within a period of 6 months from the effective date.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) The loan is already being drawn and utilised by ONGC and is meant of financing its overall operations.

#### Filling up of posts of Chairmen in Public Undertakings

52. SHRIMATI SUSHILA SHANKAR ADIVAREKAR: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a number of public undertakings attached to his Ministry are at present without full-time Chairmen and Executives;

(b) if so, what are the details in this regard; and

(c) by when these posts are likely to be filled up?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI P. C. SETHI): (a) and (b) In the Department of Chemicals and Fertilizers, the post of Chairman and Managing Director, National Fertilizers Limited is the only full-time Executive post that is vacant at the moment.

In the Department of Petroleum, 3 posts of Functional Directors in Engineers India Limited, 1 post of Chairman & Managing Director in

Bongaigaon Refinery & Petrochemicals Limited, 1 post of Member (Exploration) in Oil & Natural Gas Commission, 1 post of Chairman & Managing Director & 1 post of Director (Marketing) in Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd., are vacant. Appointment of Chairman for Indo-Burmah Petroleum Company, Balmer Lawrie & Company, Bridge and Roof (India) Ltd., and Biecco Lawrie Limited are under consideration.

(c) Action for filling the posts are in hand and the posts are expected to be filled soon.

#### Improvement in T.V. Centre Srinagar

53. SHRI SHARIEF-UD-DIN SHARIQ: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) by when the improvement is likely to be made in the Television Centre at Srinagar, so that the programmes could be seen in Kupwara and other hilly areas of the Kashmir Valley;

(b) whether Government propose to construct a Television Centre at Jammu; if so, by when; and

(c) what is the community-wise percentage of employees in Television and Radio Station in Jammu and Kashmir State in all categories?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI VASANT SATHE): (a) TV signal is received in parts of Kupwara. There is no proposal at present to augment TV Centre, Srinagar to serve the hill areas in shadow zones.

(b) There is no proposal to set up a TV Relay Centre at Jammu during the Sixth Plan period.

(c) The information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.
