Pending gauge-conversion projects in Orissa

- 2395, SHRI BHAGIRATHI MAJHI: will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased state:
- (a) whether he would consider the long pending broad gauge lines conversions projects of Badmpahar to Keonjhar and Bangriposi to Gorumahisani which is demanded by tribal people of the Mayurbhanj;
- (b) if so, whether Government would give any priority to the some pending projects for upliftment of the tribal people;
- (c) if so, whether Government have taken any constructive work towards the same;
 - (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if so, how much time Government would require for above said pending projects to complete?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU): (a) The surveys for construction of a new broad gauge railway line from Badampahar to Keonjhar and for the extension of Rupsa-Bangriposi line (now under conversion) up to Gorumahisani are in progress. Further consideration of these projects would be possible once the survey reports become available.

(b) to (e) A number of railway projects have been taken up in the underdeveloped areas of Orissa on socio-economic considerations and are being progressed as per the availability of resources. However, the Railways have taken a number of initiatives to get additional resources from sources other than the normal budgetary support to expedite the completion of these projects.
