Illegal B.Ed institutions in West Bengal

(a) whether Government are aware that the Hon'ble High Court at Kolkata has ordered that the newly set up private B.Ed, institutions, in West Bengal, were being run illegally without having proper affiliation from the NCTE and as a result thereof the future of a few thousand students has become uncertain;

(b) who is responsible for playing with the future of so many students; and

(c) What remedial steps are being taken by the Central Government?

PURANDESWARI): (a) to (c) The Government's attention has been drawn to the fact of a number of unrecognized teacher education institutions functioning in West Bengal.
