THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGA-TION (SHRI Z. R. ANSARI): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. All works required for the safety of the Farakka Barrage Complex have been undertaken by the Project Authorities. The protective measures in other reaches are to be undertaken by the West Bengal Government. However, with a view to help the State Government, the Central Government took up the question of sharing with the State Government the cost of anti-erosion works by the other beneficiaries, like the Roads and the Railways in the areas where such installations exist. The State Government has been requested to furnish a recast scheme showing the minimum cost of such works and cost-benefit ratio and the same is still awaited from the State Government.

No proposals for any specific projects in Bhutan on the other rivers have so far been received from the State Government for consideration of Government of India for being taken up with the Royal Government of Bhutan at the appropriate time.
