cidents of minor assaults and counter assaults between the two communities were reported. On 4th August, 1981, a mob of about 200 Caste Hindus set fire to houses of Harijans. houses and 5 goats and a tyre cart were completely burnt. A hand-pump was also damaged Loss is estimated to be about Rs. 6.00 lakhs. 23 Harijans sustained injuries. Police force rushed immediately an'd restored order. 50 Caste Hindus and two Harijang were arrested. Accommodattion and relief by way of food, clothes etc. were provided. Besides all these measures a cash relief of Rs. 400 - to each affected family was given. Peace Committee was formed and its meeting conducted on 5th August, 1981.

According to the State Government, the situation is now calm and under close watch. The State Government have instructed the District Collectors and Police officers to take suitable action for preventing atrocities.

Chinese and American Balloons landing in U.P.
