

Vide an order dated 1st July 1981, the Delhi High Court has stayed on an interim basis the revision of the prices of Betamethasone, its derivatives and the formulations based thereon. It is, therefore, not possible at present to say when the proposed reduction in prices can be effected.

**Panel for promotion to Station Engineer in AIR**

2402. SHRI JAGDISH PRASAD MATHUR: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is fact that the D.P.C. increased the panel for the promotion to the post of Station Engineer, in All India Radio to 46 from 33;

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor; and

(c) what are the particulars of Assistant Station Engineers who were eligible for consideration by the D.P.C. as compared to those who have been selected?

THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI VASANT SATHE):

(a) and (b) Since 13 additional vacancies were anticipated and it would be appropriate to fill up such vacancies with candidates duly empanelled, the Departmental Promotion Committee was requested and it recommended a panel of 46 candidates.

(c) In all, 114 Assistant Station Engineers were eligible and were duly considered as per the prescribed procedure. The panel was recommended out of this number.

**Public Telephone Booth at Agartala Airport**

(a) whether it is a fact that there is no public telephone booth (PCO)
