THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE AND STEEL AND MINES (SHRI PRA-NAB MUKHERJEE): (a) and (b) No, Sir. SAIL is already receiving coking coal from Canada. Against the global tenders issued in August, 1980 for supply of one million-tonnes of coking coal, letters of intent have been issued on 9-2-1981 for import of 0.6 million tonnes from Canada, Australia and U.S.A.
