(a) what is the amount of money spent by the Cooperative for American Relief Everywhere (CARE) in India during 1980-81;

(b) what was the State-wise distribution thereof;

(c) what are the various schemes on which this amount is spent; and

(d) what is the extent of involvement of local authorities in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI-MATI SHEILA KAUL): (a) to (d) CARE contributed Rs. 9,779,895 towards non-food programmes in 10 States and 2 Union Territories during 1980-81 as capital assistance for child welfare and nutrition projects like construction of Balwadis, godowns, etc. Besides, CARE delivered 392,460,739 pounds of food assistance for nutrition feeding programme in 14 States and 2 Union Territories. State-wise distribution is given in the attached statements. Both non-food and food programmes are formulated and implemented by the concerned States/Union Territories with the approval of Government of India.
