**Funds for centrally-sponsored or aided rural development schemes in West Bengal**

2842. SHRI MUKUL ROY: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) how much Central funds, for the centrally-sponsored or aided

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rural development schemes, have been released to the West Bengal Government during the last three financial years; item-wise;

(b) how much of such funds have been actually utilised by the State Government, year-wise;

(c) what are the reasons for failure to utilize such Central funds; and

(d) what steps have been taken by the Central Government to ensure utilization of such funds in future?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SURYAKANTA PATIL): (a) and (b) The Ministry of rural Development has released an amount of Rs. 2996.85 crores to the Government of West Bengal during the last three years *i.e.* 2003-04, 2004-05 and 2005-06 for implementation of main Centrally Sponsored Rural Development Schemes. Scheme-wise and Year-wise details of such funds released by the Ministry and utilised by the Government of West Bengal during this period given in the enclosed statement. (See below).

(c) The utilization of total available funds under these schemes in West Bengal is lower than the national average. There are multiple reasons like cyclones, floods and elections etc. for slow progress in implementation of rural development programmes in the State.

(d) With a view that the State Governments may utilise maximum amount of the available funds in accordance with the programme guidelines, the Ministry has developed a comprehensive system of monitoring, review and impact assessment of the programmes including utilization of funds through Periodical Progress Reports, Performance of Review Committee, Area Officer's Scheme, Vigilance and Monitoring Committee at the State/District Level with greater involvement of Members of Parliament, National Level Monitors and District Level Monitoring to monitor quality of work, adherence to implementation of schemes as per programme guidelines. Besides, the State have been advised to adopt a five-pronged strategy consisting of (i) creation of awareness about the schemes, (ii) transparency, (iii) people's participation, (iv) accountability-social audit through Gram Sabha and (v) strict monitoring and vigilance.
