(b) if so, what are the places selected for this purpose and what are the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (MISS KUMUD-BEN M. JOSHI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The two centres are proposed to be located at Calcutta and Bangalore for the Eastern and Southern Region. These centres have been selected after taking into consideration the relative merits and advantages and they will cover all the Eastern and Southern States.

**Seminar on reporting for radio held in Delhi**

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (MISS KUMUD-BEN M. JOSHI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) No specific suggestions were made or resolutions passed at the Conference. However, in the course of the speeches and the discussions which followed, some ideas have been thrown up. A report on the proceedings of the Seminar is under preparation. The question of taking action by Government will arise only after the report is received and studied.
