THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI A. P. SHARMA): (a) During the Five Year Plan 1980—85, the Department has, subject to availability of funds, proposed the purchase o'f a 45-seater motor launch for the operation of inter-island cruises.

(b) A undertaken survey was jointly by the Central Department of Tourism and Air-India in 1973 for assessing the tourism potential of the Lakshadweep Islands. As a result, restrictions to one of the entry islands, namely the Bangaram Island, were relaxed for introducing tourism. 16 cottages (32 beds) have been constructed on this island by the Hotel Corporation of India. These have been leased out to the Travel Corporation of India, an approved travel agency, which is promoting tourism to the Bangaram Island.

## Price situation in the country

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI R. VENKATARAMAN): (a) During the current fiscal year, between March 29, 1980 and January 24,, 1981, the Wholesale Price Index increased by 13.3 per cent compared with 19.5 per cent and 1.4 per cent in the corresponding periods of 1979-80 and 1978-79 respectively.

A number of anti-inflationary measures have already been taken which have helped in moderating the inflationary pressures during the current year. Government i<sub>s</sub> keeping the price situation under surveillance and further measures will be taken in the light of emerging trends.
