

Exempting security searches of service chiefs at airports

2775. SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the three chiefs of Army, Air Force and Navy are not exempted from security searches at airports, while many politicians and bureaucrats are; and

(b) if so, Government propose to give such senior officers of our armed forces the same status as politicians, ambassadors and bureaucrats *vis-a-vis* airport security?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE): (a) and (b) As per existing instructions, the chiefs of Army, Air Force and Navy are not exempted from pre-embarkation security checks at airports. There is no proposal with the Ministry of Civil Aviation to exempt the three service chiefs from pre-embarkation security checks at airports.
