THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION
AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI S. B.
CHAVAN): According to the information
received from the Jawaharlal Nehru Uni-
versity, the information in respect of parts
(a) to (d) of the question is as follows:—

(a) and (b) The amount of salary paid
to the staff of the University in 1979-80
and 1980-81 is as under:—

The amount of over-time allowance paid
to the non-teaching staff during 1979-80
was Rs. 6.63 lakhs. The estimated expen-

diture of over-time allowance paid during
1980-81 would be about Rs. 7 lakhs.

As the accounts for the months of
January and February, 1981 have not yet
been reconciled, the figures of expenditure
for the year 1980-81 are based on actuals
for the first 10 months and estimated ex-
penditure for the months of January and
February, 1981.
