(c) PERT Charts have been prepared for each construction work laying down the target dates for the completion of different stages and aspects of construction. All these works are expected to be ready in time for the Asian Games. The progress reports on each of these works are submitted by the construction agencies every fortnight and these reports are reviewed by the Works Committee and the Steering Committee regularly. The progress so far is satisfactory.
