in the Five Year Plan documents. The Sixth Plan (1980—85) document lays appropriate stress o^ work experience and vocationalisation and for making education increasingly oriented to employment opportunities.

(b) In the past two to three years, allotment to wheat wag made as ppr demands received from the State Governments. It was found that lifting was lower than the allotments made. Keeping in view the difficult wheat situation which developed in the country in mid 1980. the Eillot-mentg of wheat to the State Governments and Union Territories for public distribution system and the roller flour mills were rationalised since August^ 1980^ so as to bring the allotments near about the offtake. Accordingly the allotmentg of wheat were reduced for the various State Governments/Union Territories including Uttar Pradesh.
