The c'lllotments made for the maintenance and repairs of National Highway in Karnataka have been progi'es;»iveiy increasing over the years and during the current year so far an amount of Rs. 224.05 lakhs, which is an all-time high, has been allotted.

(d) Proposals have been received from the States, including Karnataka, for inclusion Of certain roads under National Highway System. The question of taking over of any road in Karnataka as also ia other States; will depend upon the provision that may be made for new additions to National Highway System in the 1980—85 Plan, which is still to be finalised, criteria laid down for the purpose and *inter se* priorities between various proposal^ from all States and quarters.

Raising of Kashmir issue in the Islamic summit by Pakistan President

452. SHRI K. L. N. PRASAD; Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Pakistan President raked up the Kashmir issue while addressing the 37 Motion Islamic summit on the 21st January, 1981;
