Setting up of Industries in Kerala

1037. SHRI PATTIAM RAJAN: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) what are the details of applications received by the Central Government from the entrepreneurs to set up industrial units in Kerala during the last one year; and

(b) how many letters of Intents and licences have been given so far against these applications?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI P. A. SANGMA): (a) 55 applications for the grant of industrial licences were received in 1980 for setting up industries in Kerala State. Out of these, 27 applications were for setting up New Units, 17 for the manufacture of New Articles, 10 for Substantial Expansion and one for New A Substantial Expansion.

(b) 12 Letters of Intent have so far been granted against these applications.

Marine Products freezing capacity

Setting up of large capacity cement plant

(b) if so, what are the details thereof indicating also the period for which these proposals are pending with Government and giving the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI P. A. SANGMA): (a) and (b) There are only two cases. Of setting up large capacity cement plants of one million tonnes capacity pending consideration with the Government in which cases no decision has yet been communicated to the parties. These applications are in the final stages of consideration. Details of these applications are given below:—
