THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COAL (DR. DASARI NARAYANA RAO): (a) An MoU between Coal India Limited (CIL) and Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) was signed on 31st January, 2004 for construction of a super speciality hospital as a joint venture of KMC and CIL.
