01.04.04. This was based on a review of the funds available and prioritization of assistance to various Sub-Sectors giving importance to perishables and the need to raise farmers' incomes by reducing wastage.

## Policy for betterment of FPIs and Agri-business

- 2. SHRI T.S. BAJWA: Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that Empowered Committee of Ministers had approved the policy for the betterment of food processing industries and Agri-business;
  - (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the areas in which the intending enterpreneurs are likely to be benefited?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI SUBODH KANT SAHAI): (a) to (c) The Government have constituted a Group of Ministers (GoM) on Integrated Strategy for promotion of Agri-business—vision, strategy & action plan for the food processing sector. The GoM will consider various action plans, such as, tax regime, infrastructure status to the investments in food processing industries, private and FDI in infrastructure, availability of processable raw materials, capacity building of small and unorganized sector, institutional framework, Integrated Food Law with a single apex regulator, etc. with a view to promote investments in the Sector. The GoM has not yet finalized its recommendations.
