Prices of essential consumer goods in Delhi

180. SHRI KALRAJ MISHRA:
SHRI LAL K. ADVANI:

Will the Minister of CIVIL SUPPLIES be pleased to state:

(a) what are the details of monthly prices of each of the essential consumer goods in Delhi during the last fifteen months; and

(b) what are the reasons for the rise in prices?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL SUPPLIES (SHRI BRAJMOHAN MOHANTY):

(a) The information is given in a statement at Annex. (See Appendix CXVIII Annexure No. 8).

(b) The rise in prices of some essential commodities, apart from the general inflationary pressures in the economy, may be attributed to the after-effects of the unprecedented drought of 1979, fall in production of some essential commodities, increase in the prices of petro-products on more than one occasion, continuation of high rates of inflation in other countries, increase in administered prices of some commodities, increase in support/procurement prices, transport bottlenecks and the seasonality factor.

Construction of Houses by Co-operative House Building Societies in Delhi
