### 100 per cent export oriented unit scheme

(c) whether cash compensatory  
support is another incentive which is  
being considered at the official level;  
and

(d) whether this scheme has evoked  
good response?

THE MINISTER OF STATE [IN THE  
MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI  
SHIVRAJ V. PATIL): (a) to (c) The  
Government have set up a task Force under  
the Chairmanship of Shri P. L. Tandon,  
President, National Council of Applied  
Economic Research (NCAER), to review the  
working of both the Free Trade Zones and  
also the 100 per cent Export Oriented Scheme  
with a view to examine the adequacy of  
existing facilities granted and to recommend  
future strategy etc.

(d) Yes, Sir. Up to the end of 1981, 186  
applications were received under the Scheme.  
Out of these, 103 applications have been  
approved.
