memorable experience to all the tourists and visitors to Agra in general and Taj Mahal in particular and to create and provide facilities and infrastructure of of the highest order. Ministry of Tourism had commissioned HUDCO to prepare a Project report and HUDCO's project proposal of Rs. 39.34 crore was submitted to the State Government for detailed examination. The State Government has recommended the same for approval and in the first phase, the proposal for the "Development of East Gate Entry to Taj Mahal" for Rs. 767.00 lakh has already been sanctioned during the year 2005-06.
