Proposal for two Supreme Courts

Will the Minister of LAW, JUSTICE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Chairman of the Law Commission has advocated two separate Supreme Courts, one to deal with Constitutional cases and the other to deal with appeals;

(b) if so, what are the details of the proposal; and

(c) whether the other members of the Law Commission agree with the proposal advocated by the Chairman?

THE MINISTER OF LAW, JUSTICE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS (SHRI JAGAN NATH KAUSHAL): (a) and (b) In the Course of a Presidential Conference, the Chairman Law Commission expressed as his personal view that there should be a Constitutional Court to deal exclusively with cases relating to constitutional law and a separate court of appeal with equal powers to handle cases relating to other laws. These, however, were the tentative and personal views of the Chairman and according to him, were liable to modification in the light of the response to the Questionnaire issued by the Commission.
