THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA):

(a) The number of Telephones which remained out of order continuously for more than one week during 1980-81 in Gauhati is 538 and Dibrugarh—Nil.

(b) The number of complaints received by the Department against lack of response on the part of fault-repairing staff during 1980-81 at Gauhati is 6 and at Dibrugarh—Nil.

(c) The number of complaints received regarding over billing during 1980-81 at Gauhati is 309 and at Dibrugarh—21.

The number of connections disconnected due to non-payment of bills during 1980-81 at Gauhati is 103 and at Dibrugarh—Nil.

Rehabilitation of new migrants from Erstwhile East Pakistan

1218. **SHRI ROBIN KAKATI:** Will the Minister of SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has sanctioned a further sum of Rs 205.47 lakhs for rehabilitation of new migrants from erstwhile Pakistan and what was the total amount spent previously for relief and rehabilitation of them;

(b) if so, what is their total number and number of those living at present in different States and Union territories;

(c) whether Government have any estimate of such new migrants who entered India from Bangladesh after March 1971 to the end of 1981 and if so, what is their number and the amount spent so far for their rehabilitation and relief; and

(d) if the answer to part (c) above be in the negative, whether Government propose to undertake a survey regarding the number of new migrants who have entered India from Bangladesh during the period from March 1971 to the end of 1981?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION (SHRI GIRIDHAR GOMANGO): (a) The Department of Rehabilitation have been incurring expenditure on the relief and rehabilitation of new migrants from former East Pakistan (now Bangladesh) since January, 1964. As some of the Projects/Schemes under implementation like the Dandakaranya Project are for the benefit of both old and new migrants, it is not possible to furnish separate expenditure figures for new migrants. The total amount of expenditure incurred under relief and rehabilitation of both old and new migrants upto January, 1982 is Rs. 603.14 crores. The expenditure incurred during the current year upto January, 1982 for rehabilitation of old and new migrants is Rs. 155.40 lakhs.

(b) A total number of 11.14 lakh persons came to India between 1-1-1964 and 25-3-1971 out of whom 6 lakhs stayed on in West Bengal on their own. The number of families of new migrants settled in different States and Union Territories and in Dandakaranya Project is 67,976 (approximately 3,05,892 persons).

(c) and (d) The Government of India do not allow any migrants from Bangladesh to India. All those who come from Bangladesh on Passport and visa must go back to their country on the expiry of visa and those who come illegally are illegal entrants and are made to leave India as and when

they are detected by the concerned authorities. Persons coming from Bangladesh after March, 1971 are not refugees. The question of their rehabilitation and relief in India does not, therefore, arise.

Preparation of Plans for increase in power generation by Punjab Government

1219. SHRI DHARAMCHAND JAIN: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Punjab Government have prepared plans for the increase in power generation to the extent of 60 per cent by 1984-85; and

(b) if so, what are the details of the plans in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI VIKRAM MAHAJAN): (a) The Government of Punjab have projected increases in the power generation in the State to the extent of 53.5 per cent by 1984-85.

(क) क्या मध्य प्रदेश विद्युत मंडल के पास ऐसी भी कोई व्यवस्था है जिसके द्वारा 400 के डबल्यू क्षमता तक की पारेषण लाइनों का निर्माण विभागीय तौर पर किया जाता है ;

(ख) क्या मध्य प्रदेश में पारेषण लाइनों की निर्माण लागत अन्य राज्यों की निर्माण लागत की तुलना में कम है ;

(ग) यदि हां, तो क्या राष्ट्रीय ताप विद्युत निगम के लिए पारेषण लाइनों का निर्माण मध्य प्रदेश विद्युत मंडल द्वारा किये जाने का कोई प्रस्ताव विचाराधीन है ; और
