(e) whether the above recommendations have been accepted by Government?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND. IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIA-MENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLI-KARJUN): (a) Length: 3495 Metres.

Estimated Cost: (Railway's portion only) Rs. 43 crores for Main Bridge approximately. Rs. 13 crores for Guide bund.

Total: Rg. 56 crores.

(b) Yes.

(c) The length of the bridge had to be increased taking into account the erosion on the South bank: of the river. The revised length of the bridge is given in reply to part (a). The revised length of the guide bund is 1470 Metres.

(d) No changes in the bridge or guide recommended bund were bv the Tripathy Committee. The Com mittee's terms of reference did not cover measures for protecting Nowgong District from Flood. The Com recommended provision mittee of spurs on the south bank as an experi mental measure to chanalise the flow and to induce siltation.

(e) The recommendation mad_e by the Committee a_s explained in reply to part (d) was accepted.

(e) Sinking of four wellg on the North Bank is in progress. Collection of boulders for the guide bund work is in progress. Construction of Office building and staff quarters have been completed. Actual work on the guide bund and approaches will be taken up later on.

(a) whether it is a fact that two person_s wer_e killed and three injured when the Bombay bound Jayanti Janata Expres_g from Trivandrum ran into a crowd of people at Wadakaneheri Railway Station recently;

(b) if so. the details thereof;

(c) whether any $_{e}$ nquiry has been conducted in this regard; and

(d) if so. the outcome thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIA-MENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLI-KARJUN): (a) and (b) Yes. On 2-3-1982 while No. 82 Up Trivandrum Central Bombay Janata Express was o_n run between Wadakaneheri and Mullurcarai stations 5 persons, presumably trespassers on their way to a festival at local Bhagwathi Temple were knocked down by the train, resulting in the death of 2 and injuries to 3.

(c) and (d) The Police have registered a case and the result of their investigation i_s awaited.

Coastal Farmers Adopting Prawns Cultivation

(i) Coastal farmers are increasingly switching over from agriculture to lucrative prawn culture, because there is no expenditure involved on labour and fertiliser

(ii) In the Karwa_r Kharlands, the farmers are no longer interested in j desalinating their soil but, on the other hand they cut the bundhs and let th_e sea water in for rearing prawns.

(iii) The thrust during the past 3 decade_s had been towards extending) grain crops, regardles_g of roil suitability.
