2273. DR. JOSEPH LEON D' SOUZA: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) the annual sales turnover of Becosules marketed by M/s. Pfizer;

(b) the composition and packings under which Becosules is being marketed;

(c) what is the price of Becosules and whether it is a fact that this product is being marketed without obtaining any price approval from his Ministry, thus making huge profit;

(d) if so, what action Government propose to take in this regard and by when the consumer will get Becosules at fair and reasonable price; and

(e) what steps Government propose to take to recover the unintended profit made by this company?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM, CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI DALBIR SINGH): (a) and (b) The following table gives the composition, pack size and trade sales of Becosules capsules produced by M/s. Pfizer for the year ending May, 1981 based on the available information:

Pfizer Limited applied to the Government for fixation of price of Becosules Capsules after reformulating them in accordance with the requirement of Schedule V of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the Rules made thereunder. Government is yet to decide about the mark-up to be allowed on reformulated Schedule V formulations. In the

meanwhile M/s. Pfizer under Sub-paragraph 3 of Paragraph 14 of the Drugs (Prices Control) Order, 1979 have intimated the prices of reformulated product vide their letter dated 10th February, 1982. The price approved by the Government for pre-schedule V preparation and the price of reformulated preparation as intimated by the Company is as follows:
