

There is one project in Andhra Pradesh, namely Kakinada-Pithapuram New Broad Gauge rail line where requisite clearances have not been received for which necessary action has been initiated. However, there are a number of ongoing projects under implementation in the State which are being proposed as per availability of resources. A number of initiatives have been taken to generate additional resources to expedite completion of ongoing projects in a time frame of about five years.

Additional Financial Assistance to Andhra Pradesh for rail line

3161. SHRI C. RAMACHANDRAIAH: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Railways had sanctioned a railway line from Peddapally-Karimnagar-Nizamabad in 1993-94;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the implementation schedule of the project;

(d) whether the Government of Andhra Pradesh has sought additional financial assistance for this project; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. Peddapalli-Karimnagar-Nizamabad new line (177 km.) was included in the Budget 1993-94. Peddapalli Karimnagar (35.53 km) has been completed and commissioned. Karimnagar-Jagityal (48 km.) is targeted for completion during 2006-07.

(d) Yes, Sir.

(e) Andhra Pradesh Government had requested for the provision of Rs. 50 crore during 2006-07 for this project.

Doubling of Surat Bhusawal rail line

(a) whether Surat-Bhusawal section of the Western Railway has been included in planning for providing double lines;

(b) if so, what are the details of the planning; and

(c) by when the project is likely to be completed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU): (a) and (b) On this alignment, double broad gauge line already exists between Surat-Udhna and Jalgaon-Bhusawal sections. A survey report for doubling of Udhna-Jalgaon section is under finalisation.

(c) Does not arise as it is not sanctioned work.

Acute shortage of water at gurgaon Railway Station

(a) whether it is a fact that for the last four years there is acute scarcity/ shortage of water at Gurgaon railway station apart from frequent failure of computerized ticketing system; and

(b) if so, whether Government propose to post additional manpower to cope with the shortage of water and frequent failure of computerized ticketing system?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU): (a) On Madurai-Rameshwaram gauge conversion project, Madurai-Manamadurai section has already been commissioned and work on Manamadurai-Mandapam is targeted for completion during 2006-07.

On Tiruchchirappalli-Manamadurai gauge conversion project, work on Tiruchchirappalli-Karaikudi section is targeted for completion during 2006-07.
