Shelling of rice in Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh ..

- 313. DR. (SHRIMATI) RAJINDER KAUR: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that moveof. nearly eight lakh tonnes of paddy has taken .place from FCI godowns in Punjab to Andhra Pradesh. Rajasthan and Madhya Pradsh during the last year;
- (b) whether it is also a facfthat rice millers of Punjab were prepared to do shelling @ Rs. -4/- per quintal whereas Rs. 13/- or so per quintal have beeh paid to outside States besides Punjab losing rice bran and PCl paying extra freight on the husk; and
- (c) if so, what are reasons therefor and whether Government propose to Institute an enquiry into the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI R. V. SWAMINATHAN): (a) There has been no movement °t paddy from Food Corporation of India godowns in Punjab to Andhra Pradesh and Rajasthan during the last year. However, approximately 38,000 tonnes of paddy was moved from Punjab to Madhya Pradesh duringlast year.

lb) Rates for milling Punjab paddy in Madhya Pradesh last year .were Rs. II- per quintal for conversion into raw rice and Rs. 4 per quintal for parboiled rice. The milling rate in Punjab were however, Rs. 2,70 to Rs. 4.50 per quintal for raw rice and Rs. 4.50 per quintal for "parboiled rice.

to Questions

(c) The movement was undertaken to relieve the pressure on Punjab millers and expedite paddy milling. The question of an enquiry does not arise.

Centre of Agro-Energy Research

- (SHRIMATI) Will HEPTULLA: th_e Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the proposed Centre of Agro-Energy Research has started working; and
- (b) whether six plants have been set up in the metropolitan cities for recycling solid and liquid wastes?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI R. V. SWAMINATHAN): (a) Mot yet. The proposal for the establishment of a Centre on Agro-Energy Research has been included in the 6th Plan 1980—85 proposal of the Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi. This is still under consideration of tKe Government.

(b) There is n₀ proposal under consideration Indian Council of Agricultural Research/Department of Agricultural Research and Education for setting up of six plants in metropolitan cities. The Department of Agriculture (Fertilizer Division) has however, set up mechanical compost plants in six cities namely; Ahmeda-bad, Vadodara, - Calcutta,-Bangalore, Bombay and Jaipur at which compositing of urban wastes is undertaken.
