Socio-Economic Development of Backward Region

- (a) what is the *per capita* incom« of the people of the five districts oS Cooch Behar, Jalpaiguri, Darjeellng, West Dinajpur and Malda in North Bengal; and
- (b) what are the details of the programmeg that have been taken up or are likely to be taken up by Government for socio-economic development of this backward region?

THE MINISTER OF PLANNING (SHRI S. B. CHAVAN); (a) Date regarding per capita income of the districts in West Bengal is not maintained in Planting Commssion.

(b) Besides programmes in the normal plan of the State, there are certain Central programmes for area* with special problems. In the M* of West Bengal all the Ave district* mentioned in (a) above have been declared as industrially backward districts to qualify concessional finance from the financial institution! Besides this, three subdivision₉ of the DarjeelSig district are included in the hill areas programme under which special Central assistance is admissible for approved programmes of development. Thi districts of Malda, Darjeellng, Jalpaiguri and West Dinajpur in North Bengal are also covertd under the Integrated Tribal Development Programme.
