

**Proposal of Japan Government for carrying out of
Netaji's ashes**

†219. SHRI KALRAJ MISHRA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government of Japan has put a proposal before Government for carrying ashes of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose from Rankoji Temple;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the reaction of Government thereto?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI S. REGUPATHY): (a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c) Do not arise.

Disappearing of foreign nationals

†220. MISS ANUSUIYA UIKEY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of foreigners who came to India and disappeared during the period from 1st January, 2003 to 31st January, 2006 and the names of countries they belonged to;

(b) the efforts made by Government to search and deport them to their countries of origin; and

(c) the number of foreigners who went to Madhya Pradesh and disappeared from there giving the details regarding their names and their countries?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI SHRIPRAKASH JAISWAL): (a) As per readily available information, the number of foreigners who came to India and did not take exit within period of validity of visa *i.e.* overstayed during the year 2003 to 2005 is given in the Statement-I (See below).

(b) Foreigners, visiting on short-term/tourist visa, not exceeding stay of 180 days, are not required to register themselves with Foreigners Regional Registration Officers (FRROs)/Foreigners Registration Officers (FROs) and hence overstay of such foreigners does not come to immediate notice of authorities. However, law enforcement agencies maintain a vigil to intercept such overstaying/missing foreigners. With the efforts put in by various agencies, 10,829 Bangladeshis, 94 Afghan nationals, 7 Sudanese, 371 Pakistani and 2 Yemen national were intercepted and deported from the country during the year 2005.

(c) As per readily available information, the number of foreigners who got themselves registered with FROs in Madhya Pradesh and did not seek exit and thus found to have overstayed during the same period i.e. 2003 to 2005 is given in the Statement-II.
