REFERENCE TO ACCIDENT TO A NOIDA STAFF BUS

श्री कलराज मिश्र (उत्तर प्रदेश) : इसके पहले कि कॉलिंग अटेंशन लिया जाय मैं आज की एक दुखद दुर्घटना के बारे में सदन का ध्यान आकषित करना चाहता हूँ। आज हो जनकपुरी से नोयडा जाने वाली स्टाफ बस निजामुद्दीन पुल के आगे हिंडन नहर में गिर पड़ी

जिस में 32 लोग मर गये हैं और 12 लोगो की लाशें निकाल ली गयी हैं और 20 लोग लापता हैं। 28 लोग उस में घायल अवस्था में हैं अस्पताल में हैं। मैं चाहूंगा कि इस संबंध में माननीय मंत्री जी अपना वक्तव्य दें ताकि वास्तविक स्थिति की जानकारी हो सके और इस संबंध में जो लोग मर गये हैं अगर उन को सदन की तरफ से समवेदना दी जाय तो ज्यादा उपयुक्त होगा।

श्री सुन्दर सिंह भंडारी (उत्तर प्रदेश) : अभी कॉलिंग अटेंशन एक घंटा चलेगा। अगर सरकार इस बीच में कोई इंफार्मेशन कलेक्ट कर ले और कुछ इंफार्मेशन दे सके हाउस को तो मैं लीडर आफ दि हाउस से प्रार्थना करूंगा कि वे इस बारे में इंफार्मेशन दें। बहुत बड़ी दुर्घटना हो गयी है। 35 आदमी मर गये हैं निजामुद्दीन के पास। तो इस बारे में सदन को सूचना तो मिलनी चाहिए।

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI BHISHMA NARAIN SINGH): It is 5 o'clock and tomorrow is a holiday.

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: All right. Let him make enquiries into it.

SHRI SUNDER SINGH BHANDARI: Can you give an assurance?

SHRI SUNDER SINGH BHANDARI: When will they report to the House? Will it be possible to report by 6 o'clock, if it is possible?

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: If it is not possible today, it may be any day.

SHRI SUNDER SINGH BHANDARI: It is very near Delhi.

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: If it is possible today they will do it. otherwise they will do it next day. Shrimati Kanak Mukherjee.

CALLING ATTENTION TO A MATTER OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE—

Reported collapse of fly-over under construction, in connection with ASIAD, at Sewa Nagar—Defence Colony in South Delhi, causing injury to 25 labourers—contd.

SHRIMATI KANAK MUKHERJEE: Sir, the collapse of fly-over near the Asian Games site is not a simple accident. It is a great calamity.

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Order please.

SHRIMATI KANAK MUKHERJEE: It is a scandal for the whole nation. The prestige of our country in organising the Asian Games has been lowered because this accident exposes the extreme corruption and the greed of the vested circles, particularly nurtured by the Government itself. After that accident we 5 P.M. are not sure whether only 24 men and women labourers were injured and we are not sure also whether any dead bodies would be found after all the debris is cleared.

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: There is no dead body.

SHRIMATI KANAK MUKHERJEE: Moreover, I was shocked to know from a news item in the Statesman that the police behaved in a fishy and funny way when reporters went to the hospital. What they wanted to hide, we do not know. What games are going on behind the Asian Games, I do not know. Only a part of it has been exposed through this accident.

We have now come to know that it was under the railways. The railways passed it over to the NPCC, the NPCC gave it to a contractor and the contractor gave it for sub-contract. We know these things but we do not know how to find the culprit and punish him. We know that all those are by-products of the Government at the Centre. So we want the Government and the Ministry themselves to tell us about this.

These are my simple questions: Is the Government going to set up a judicial inquiry into the accident? Secondly, has the Government recel-
