REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON PETITIONS

SHRI SANKAR PRASAD MITRA (West Bengal) : Sir, I beg to present the Seventy-first Report of the Committee on Petitions on the petition signed by Shrimati Vimla Farooqui, General Secretary and four other office-bearers of the National Federation of Indian Women, New Delhi, regarding rise prices of essential commodities and matters connected therewith.

RE. PRIVILEGE MOTION AGAINST THE MINISTER

SHRI ARVIND GANESH KULKARNI (Maharashtra) : I have given a notice of Privilege Motion against Mr. Sisodia for a statement made in reply to a question by Mr. Bagaikar about the bag kept in the Custom House by Mr. Lakkappa. That Privilege Motion is with you. Tomorrow is the last day. I would request that this Privilege Motion should be discussed and considered by you and we may be allowed to make our points tomorrow.

SHRI SADASHIV BAGAIKAR (Maharashtra) : I have also given a Privilege Motion.

SHRI ARVIND GANESH KULKARNI: You see the reply of 22nd December. He has said that Mr. Lakkappa has kept the luggage in the Custom House. Mr. Sisodia himself replied.

MR. CHAIRMAN : You are anxious to bring the name in ; that is all. When I receive a motion of privilege, I do not act with the expedition which probably other legislative bodies employ because I think it is a serious matter and needs a little thinking. If people can do that, can do 60 Privilege Motions in one day; there is no difficulty about that. But would it be right for this House to do this at that speed ?

SOME HON. MEMBERS : No.

MR. CHAIRMAN : I think it will take time. It has come this morning; I will read them today and decide.

SHRI PILOO MODY (Gujarat) : Let the man guilty of it explain.
