Allocation for Commonwealth Games

396. SHRI MANOHAR JOSHI: Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have allocated any budget to Commonwealth Games 2010;

(b) if so, the details of the budget;

(c) the infrastructural development plan in Delhi in this regard; and

(d) the list of flyovers, under passes and other road connectivity projects?

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI MANI SHANKAR AIYAR): (a) and (b) While the detailed proposals of the various agencies entrusted with responsibilities for creating facilities and infrastructures for the Commonwealth Games are under finalization, the Government of India has, so far, made a provision of Rs. 150 crores in the current financial year for meeting the requirements of the Organising Committee of the Commonwealth Games, 2010, Sports Authority of India and preparation of the Indian Contingent for the Commonwealth Games.

(c) In the context of Commonwealth Games, 2010 the Government of NCT of Delhi has submitted a proposal to the Planning Commission for
