Upgradation of Railway Stations

515. SHRI MAHENDRA MOHAN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a detailed plan has been drawn up to upgrade railway stations throughout the country and, in the first phase, 327 railway stations have been selected to be developed as model stations with modern facilities;

(b) if so, the details thereof, including the names of railway stations selected for upgradation and the present status of its implementation, State-wise;

(c) the criteria evolved for selection of the 327 railway stations for upgradation; and

(d) the details of the phased programme drawn up for upgradation of the remaining stations also?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU): (a) and (b) With a view to provide upgraded passenger amenities, 578 stations have been nominated as model stations, out of which 327 stations were nominated prior to the presentation of Railway Budget 2006-07. Details of the 578 stations nominated so far zone-wise are given in Statement-I. (See Below). 110 stations have been developed

as Model Station. The list of 110 stations zone-wise is given in Statement-II. (See below) Railway do not maintain State-wise list.

(c) While presenting the Railway Budget 1999-2000, the then Minister of Railways declared that all efforts will be made to make at least one station in each division as model station where higher level of passenger amenities will be provided. Consequent upon the announcement so made, 61 stations were initially selected as model station. Later on, more model stations were added from time to time. Now as per the announcement made during the presentation of Railway Budget 2006-07, all 'A' and 'B' category stations have been selected as model stations.

(d) 327 stations which were declared as Model Stations prior to Railway Budget 2006-07, are targeted to be developed by March, 2008.
