(a) whether CBI investigation in certain operations of the Continental Overseas Corporation in India have been completed;

(b) if so, what are the details of operations in respect of which investigations have been made; and

(c) what are the results of the investigations?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL RECONSTRUCTION (SHRI R. V. SWAMINATHAN): (a) to (c) On suspicion that an Upper Division Clerk of Union Department of Food passed on official documents to unauthorised persons/companies like the Continental Overseas Corporation, the Central Bureau of Investigation arrested him in August, 1981. The matter is

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL RECONSTRUCTION (SHRI R. V. SWAMINATHAN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) At present, the existing set up of the Food Corporation of India in the North-Eastern Region is considered to be adequate. It is, therefore, not possible to agree to this demand.
