2713. SHRI DHARAMCHAND JAIN: Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state;

(a) the details of the fatal accidents and accidents involving serious injuries in IISCO AND TISCO during the last three years, Company-wise;

(b) what is the amount of compensation/payment against life cover scheme made in each case; and

(c) what are the details of the cases in which the compensation/payment against life cover scheme has not been made so far along with reasons therefor?

(a) whether it is a fact that M/s. K. L. Rathi Steel Mill has violated the income-tax rules and a huge amount of black money is being collected from its selling agents by selling steel without any proper receipt; and

(b) if so, whether Government propose to raid the premises immediately to unearth the black money of the company?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI SAWAI SINGH SISODIA): (a) and (b) Since, amongst others, there were allegations against M/s. K. L. Rathi Steels Ltd. that purchases and stocks

were outside the books of account, the Income-tax authorities had searched the premises of M/s. K. L. Rathi Steels Ltd., allied concerns and the residential premises of their Directors/partners in November, 1975.

Central Undertakings in Kerala

(a) what are the names of Central Government Undertakings located in Kerala and what is the authorised capital of each of them; .

(b) what is the number of employees working in each such undertakings; and

(c) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to set up any new public undertakings in Kerala, if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI SAWAISINGH SISODIA): (a) and (b) A statement showing the names of Central public sector enterprises with their registered office located in Kerala, authorised capital and the total number of employees working in such undertakings as on 31-3-81 is enclosed.

(c) A new company is going to be incorporated to take over the construction and operation of the newsprint manufacturing project of Hindustan Paper Corporation coming up in Kottayam district of Kerala. This project with 80,000 tonnes of annual newsprint capacity costing about Rs. 134 crores is likely to generate direct employment to 1800 persons and indirect employment to about 10,000 persons.
