(b) the reasons for which these proposals are not being considered; and

(c) the number of districts of Madhya Pradesh still deprived of railway lines?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU): (a) and (b) The proposal of third line between Bina and Bhopal has been processed for obtaining requisite clearances. Field survey of Bhopal-Itarsi section has been completed.
