#### Employment generated under the National Rural Employment Programme

418. SHRIMATI KANAK MUKHERJEE: Will the Minister of RURAL RECONSTRUCTION be pleased to state:

(a) what is the State-wise employment generated in terms of man-days under the National Rural Employment Programme during the year 1980-81 and 1981-82;

(b) whether it is a fact that the Central foodgrains supply under the scheme has been virtually stopped with effect from 1981-82;

(c) if so, whether the programme is being abandoned; and

(d) if so, on what grounds?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL RECONSTRUCTION (SHRI BALESHWAR RAM): (a) Complete figures of employment generated State-wise in terms of man-days under National Rural Employment Programme during the year 1980-81 have not yet become available. Statement I indicating the available information is, however, enclosed. Information in regard to employment generated under the programme during the year 1981-82 have so far been furnished by 8 States UTs in respect of the first quarter only. It is contained in Statement II.

(b) to (d) The supply of foodgrains under the programme has not been stopped, nor has the programme been abandoned.
