Hearing was given to the company after a notice, as also to the objectors. After the hearing was given, again it was processed in the light of the arguments that were pressed and then, after the decision was taken, the matter has been placed on the Table of the House. This is the position.

SHRI ERA SEZHIYAN: But you have taken 20 long months.

SHRI SHIV SHANKAR: Principles of natural justice require that all these.

MR. CHAIRMAN: I know. I think the principle of natural justice also requires that the House should know a little earmer.

SHRI SHIV SHANKAR: I know, Sir. We have taken expeditious action,
