Central Excise duty vis-a-vis Sales tax

1727. SHRI K. C. SEBASTIAN: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state;

- (a) how many States have objected to Government of India's proposal to include more items under Central Excise Duty outside Sales tax:
- (b) what are the items intended to be included; and
- (c) to what extent this will adverse ly affect the States' Sales tax collections?

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI R. VENKATARAMAN); (a> to (c) The question whether the scheme on additional excise duty in lieu of sales tax could be extended to a few other essential commodities, such as cement, medicines, vanaspati and petroleum products, as recommended by the Indirect Taxation Enquiry Committee, was one of the subjects discussed at the Chief Ministers' Conference on sales tax held in New Delhi on 16th and 17th September, 1980. At the concluding session, the Conference adopted a Resolution recommending inter alia that sales tax on life saving drugs listed as such by the Hathi Committee and on vanaspati be replaced by additional excise duties.
