Commissions in the past. In the case of Moradabad, a separate Commission of Inquiry has been appointed under the Commissions of Inquiry Act to investigate the incidents which took place there on the 13th August, 1980.

Written Answers

(c) Government are conscious of tlie need for the maintenance of communal peace and harmony, and adequate guidelines on the subject have already been given to the State Governments from time to time. Government have also made known their determination to deal sternly, promptly and effectively with any situation that, will create a law and order problem anywhere.
