paper which now rule higher in
India than in the United States
or Britain and faulty methods of
distribution have crippled the
publication industry ;

(b) whether high prices of text
books were affecting the student
community as the prices of academic
books were so high now that even the
school and college libraries were
finding it difficult with their limited
resources to buy them;

(c) whether the manufacturers were
raising the prices arbitrarily because of
the stay order obtained by them from
courts on the enforcement of Paper
Control Order of 1979 and it was no
longer in force; and

(d) if so, what steps are proposed to
be taken by Government in the matter?
