THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN MINISTRY OF SUPPLY AND RE-HABILITATION (SHRI P. K. THUN-GON): (a) No, Sir.

(b) The displaced persons rehabilitated in the Project are provided relief and rehabilitation assistance as per The agriculturists prescribed norms. families are provided with developed bullocks, agricultural inputs, housing homestead well loan for subsidiary occupation and maintenance grant during the initial period settlement. The small trade/business families are provided with business loan, houses and business premises and some agricultural land in rural areas only. Infrastructural facilities as well as civic amenities like roads, irrigation projects tanks, tubewells, schools and medical institutions are provided by the Project for all settlers wherever feasible and necessary.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION (SHRI Z. R. ANSARI): (a) An irrigation potential of about 3.0 million hectares remained unutilised to the end of June 1980.
