Functioning of NCERT

(a) the number of times working of the NCERT has been reviewed since its inception; and

(b) if so, the results of the review?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI S. B. CHAVAN): (a) and (b) In 1968 the Government of India appointed a Review Committee under the Chairmanship of Dr. B. D. Nag Choudhuri to review and evaluate the activities and programmes of the NCERT and to make recommendations regarding their future role. On the basis of the recommendations made by the Committee, the NCERT was reorganised and its role redefined. In 1977-78 the Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI), Hyderabad were engaged as consultants to study the organisation and functioning of NCERT in terms of its objectives. On the basis of the recommendations made by the ASCI, action to reorganise the structure and functioning of NCERT has been initiated. In 1979, a detailed review of the NCERT was conducted by the Ministry of Education. Besides, the

annual accounts of NCERT are audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Annual Report of NCERT is laid on the Table of the Houses of Parliament every year.
