THE. DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI MAGANBHAI BAROT): (a) For the current year the World Bank have committed assistance of \$ 2 billion out of which \$ 1600 million will be provided by trie International Development Association and the remaining \$ 400 million by the World Bank. Discussions are in Progress with the World Bank to explore the possibility of securing further loans under the new World Bank facility with structural adjustment lending or otherwise.
