THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE MAGANBHAI BAROT): (a) For the current year the World Bank have committed assistance of \$ 2 billion out of which \$ 1600 million will be provided by the International Development Association and the remaining \$ 400 million by the World Bank. Discussions are in Progress with the World Bank to explore the possibility of securing further loans under the new World Bank facility with structural adjustment lending or otherwise.

- (b) As the discussions are still at a preliminary stage it is not possible to turnish any details.
- (c) The particulars of loan assistance received by Government of India from the World Bank, repayments made and debt outstanding as on 30-9-1980 are indicated below:—
