- (a) what i<sub>s</sub> the total loss incurred by the plywood Industry in Assam as a result of the blockade imposed by the agitators there;
- (b) what i<sub>s</sub> the number of industries and the number of employees effected; and
- (c) what measures have been taken by Government or the employers adpoted to give relief to the employees suffering as a result of the closure of plywood factories in Assam?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI CHARANJIT CHANANA): (a) According to the information frunished by the Federation of Indian Plywood and Panel Industry the loss incurred by the Plywood Industry in Assam as a result of the

blockade imposed by the agitators is estimated at Rs. 7.50 cror<sub>e</sub> in terms of production.

- (b) The number of unit<sub>s</sub> manu facturing plywood in Assam is 41 and the approximte number of workers i<sub>s</sub> 16,000.
- (c) According to th!e information furnished by the Federation of Indian Plywood and Panel Industry, the plywood factories in. Assam were compelled to cease production from 25th August, 1980 and the workers were paid 50 per cent of their wages for a further 45 days.
