recovery of the outstanding licence fees?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHR1 MALLIKARJUN): (a) No amount of licence fee is outstanding against the Catering/Vending Contractors of Allahabad Division for the period January, 1979 to September, 1980. However, for the earlier period, arrears of licence fee amounting to Rs. 40,915.20 are due, at present from one contractor.

(b) The arrear amount is being recovered in monthly instalments.

## Construction of Roads in Arunachal Pradesh

2703. SHRI RATAN TAMA: Will the Minister of SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government of Arunachal Pradesh have sent a proposal for the construction of Tamen-Tali Road in lower Subansiri by the GREF and BRTF (Border Road Task Force);
- (b) if so, what is the total amount involved for the construction of the said road and what is the date on which the construction is likely to start; and
- (c) the number of roads that are being taken up by Government for construction in Arunachal Pradesh by the GREF/BRTF and what are the names of the roads and their exact locations?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIP-PING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The proposal has however, been received by the Border Roads Organisation only vary recently on 15-12-1980 and it would take sometime for them to assess the cost involved and decide on other issues

regarding financing, date of commencement etc. At present two roads are under construction by GREF in Arunachal Pradesh. It is not in public interest to disclose other details.
