Foreigners issue in Assam

256. SHRI NARSINGH NARAIN PANDEY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether despite the conciliatory attitude of Government the issue of foreign nationals in Assam has remained unresolved due to adamant and inflexible attitude of the AASU and AAGSP leaders;

(b) the results of the talks, if any, so far;

(c) whether the said leaders are again threatening to reimpose blockade on the movement of jute, bamboo and crude oil; if so, the fact thereof; and

(d) the steps proposed to be taken to resume supplies and restoring law and order situation and to settle foreigners' issue?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) to (d) Several rounds of talks have been held at various levels on the foreigners' issue in Assam, but no agreed understanding has emerged due to inflexible approach adopted by the agitators. Apart from blockade of crude and plywood, blockade on movement of jute, forest products cane and bamboo has been reimposed. Government have taken all necessary steps for maintaining law and order and essential supplies. Government has kept its door open for talks and it is hoped that saner counsel will eventually prevail amongst the agitators.

Threatened intensification of stir in Assam

257. SHRI LADLI MOHAN NIGAM: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the agitators have threatened to intensify their stir to press their demands on the foreigners' issue in Assam;

(b) if so, the reasons for the breakdown in the talks; and

(c) the steps contemplated by Government to settle the issue which has already caused considerable damage to the Indian economy?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) Yes, Sir.
