**Project on Field Artillery Radar**

(b) whether a Field Artillery Radar with single target capability is being imported from the U.K.; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI SHIVRAJ V. PATIL): (a) Work on Field Artillery Radar is in progress at Electronics Radar and Development Establishment, Bangalore.

(b) and (c) Only a limited quantity of this equipment is proposed to be imported to meet the immediate requirement of the Army.

**People's army in Pakistan**

401. SHRI J. K. JAIN: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the reports that Pakistan proposes to create a people's army on the Chinese model and make a massive increase in the size of Pak armed forces;

(b) if so, Government's information about the plan for creating people's army in that country; and

(c) whether Government propose to revamp the Indian Armed Forces to match the massive increase in Pak army for ensuring an effective security against the massive arms build-up in Pakistan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI SHIVRAJ V. PATIL): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. Government have seen press reports regarding a proposal of Gen. Zia-ul-Haq, President of Pakistan for raising a People's Army on the Chinese model. There are reports to the effect that Government of Pakistan has initiated a study of conscription and other methods of augmenting military forces in other countries. There are however, as yet, no firm
